- The SRC will not be charged corporate rates for welcome week, but is getting preferred pricing
  - The stall set up we are getting is 1 block of stalls on Eastern avenue, 1 general SRC and 4 more will rotate over the 4 days

- It will be from 10-3pm Mon-Thursday
- There won't be collective signage; collectives will need to organise their own signage for the stalls
- Could the general Secs could figure out which collectives are going to be on what days, seeing as you are already coordinating with them about o-week
- We won't have a big power board – please charge in advance/ be able to rotate to keep charge up as there won't be capacity to charge devices at the stalls.

Discussion:

Anne Zhao inquired if the general secretaries/ gen-exec will be expected to be there all days 4 days.

Swapnik Sanagavarapu said there should be but that it will be spread out as long as there are always 2 people in the main SRC stall.

Scott-Curwood said he would be at another C&S stall for a lot but will come by and help out at the SRC stall too.

Priya Gupta added that there should also be a caseworker of Legal service person on the stall at times too.

Anne Zhao asked if Swapnik Sanagavarapu would like the General Secretaries to make the roster

Swapnik Sanagavarapu said that would be great if you're not too busy

It was agreed that the General Secretaries would make the roster for the SRC collective stalls and work out the timetable to secure there was always people on the stalls at all times

- Total cost for O-Week is \$3500 for the SRC stalls, over all it will be under \$5000 which is a lot less than expected at first
- We have about \$3500 was set aside for stalls, The Exec needs to approve that, if it could be considered approved when passing this report that would be great
- Another update is also during the Uni's Orientation the week before, The SRC has been offered some slots for workshop sessions through the week for Casework and Legal presentations on the work they do
- The University's Orientation Project group, have asked us to present our plans for O-Week on the 11<sup>th</sup> Feb. We will be getting things organised for that.
